
Me and my relationships - Can we identify simple qualities of friendship and suggest simple strategies for making up?

Why do we have classroom rules?

Can we identify a range of feelings and identify how they might make us behave?

Can we recognise that people's bodies and feelings can be hurt, and suggest ways of dealing with hurt?



English

Some of our Literacy work will be based on our 'Read, Write, Inc' books each week. Additional Literacy work will include a focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. We will also be writing captions and lists (Year 1) and non-chronological reports (Year 2), followed by a focus on poetry.

Maths

A variety of topics will be covered including: Year 1: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, and Shape. Year 2: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, and Shape.



Science

Children will learn how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, and will learn about seed dispersal. We will plan and carry out an investigation into the conditions needed for plant growth by planting cress. We will draw conclusions from our results and evaluate our findings.

In the second half of the term, we will learn about animals including humans.
