## English

Some of our Literacy work will be based on our 'Read, Write, Inc' books each week. Additional Literacy work will focus on writing a narrative based on The Gingerbread Man. We will then also write a set of instructions. We will have a particular focus on the language features of each genre.



## PE

**Gymnastics**—Children will be practising and performing balances and jumps, linking movements together in a sequence.


**Games** - The children will be practising their throwing and catching skills. They will learn how to aim a ball with increasing accuracy. Children will learn how to hit a ball with a bat. They will use the skills they have learnt and apply them in a team game.



## RE

We will learn about how Muslims pray and why this is important to them. We will learn about the Qur'an and the Shahada and its importance in Islam. We will look at stories of the prophet Mohammed.

In the second half of the term, we will learn about why Easter is important to Christians.



## Maths

A variety of topics will be covered including:

Year 1: Shape, Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Length and Height, Mass and Volume

Year 2: Shape, Money, Multiplication and Division, Length and Height, Mass, Capacity and Temperature



## Science

Children will be naming and identifying a range of materials, distinguishing between an object and the material it is made from. Children will learn how to identify the properties of materials, and recognise the differences between human and natural resources.

We will predict and identify which materials float and sink.



## History

### 'Neil Armstrong'

Children will learn all about Neil Armstrong and the moon-landing. We will also learn about who else has been to space and how this impacts on our life today.

### Geography:

We will be learning about the weather and identifying hot and cold places.



## Computing



**E-safety** - Children will learn what the Internet is and what people use it for. We will discuss what personal information is and why it should be kept private. Children will learn where to go for help and support if they are concerned about something they see online. We will learn why it is important to respect people online.

## Art

We will be focusing on painting skills, linking this with our class topics for the term. We will look at the artist, Matisse and will use this to inspire our own art work.
